The present perfect tense expresses actions or events that occurred at an unspecified time in the past but have relevance to the present moment.

Structure: S + have/has + past participle

Example: I have finished my work.

Structure: S + haven't/hasn't + past participle

Example: I haven't seen him today.

Structure: Have/Has + subject + past participle +?

Example: Has she visited Japan?
